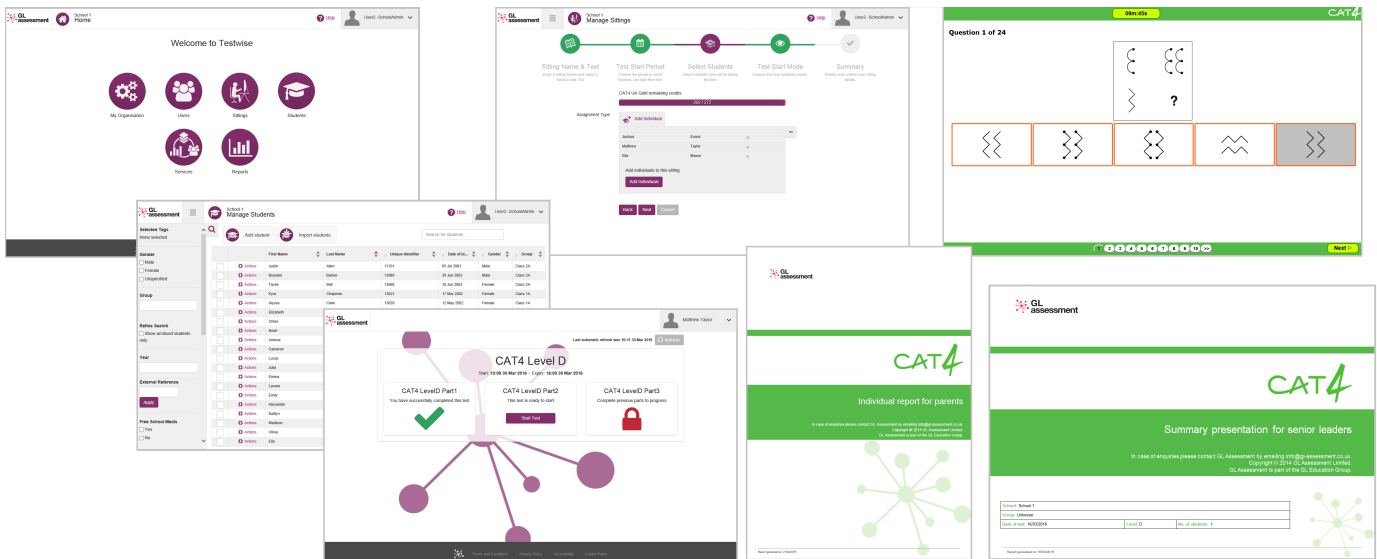

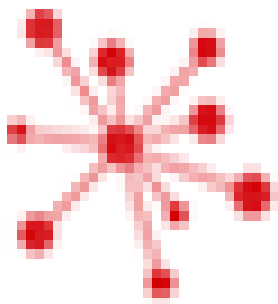
Learning to Use Testwise

Understanding the home screen

The Testwise home screen is the first page you will see when you [log into the system](#). It shows all the [functional areas](#) that you can access.

The image below shows that a user named 'User2 - SchoolAdmin' can access the [My Organisation](#), [Users](#), [Settings](#), [Students](#), [Services](#) and [Reports](#) areas of the Testwise system. Another user may have access to fewer areas of the system, which means they will be able to see fewer buttons on their home screen.



GL Assessment

Notice that in the top right of the page you can see a Help button



, which you can click whenever you want to view these online help pages.

Whenever you want to return to the home screen, click the **Home** button



which is the logo displayed on the top left of the page.
